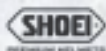

Putoline Series Round 2 Taupo Motorsport Park, Sunday 10 September

Nathan Jane takes three wins at Taupo

Riders braved cold, windy and occasional wet conditions during the second round of the Putoline Series held at Taupo Motorsport Park on Sunday September 10.

Only three races were run under actual rain, although all classes dealt with a varying wet to dry track surface which challenged riders, and the air temperature never rose above 8 degrees.

Race one of the Putoline Senior class was held on an almost dry track. Jared Love (Honda CBR600) shot straight into the lead during his comeback ride, ahead of Nick Kampenhout (Husqvarna) and Nathan Jane on his Barnes & Jenkins GSXR600. Loose bodywork forced Love to retire, while Jane forced his Suzuki into the lead from Kampenhout to take the opening premier class victory. Wellington's Ian Reed rounded out the podium.

Race two was very wet. Nick Kampenhout got the holeshot but Nathan Jane soon took the lead with a great display of precision wet riding. Kampenhout held second to the line, while Love came from the back of the grid for third. The last race of the day had a depleted field on a very wet track which saw Jane make three wins from as many starts. Adrian Clare (Yamaha R1) picked up second place, with Grant Erskine (CBR600) rounding out the podium.

The Bridgestone Intermediate class kicked off in wet conditions. Liam Underwood rode to a clear win over Jordan Burley and Michael Patchett. Race two saw a patchy wet track, Liam again showing great skills taking win number two over Jordan Burley with Nick Kampenhout rounding out the podium. Race three was back on a very wet surface. Jordan Burley shot out to an early lead, hotly pursued by Kampenhout and Underwood. Underwood fought his way into the lead on the penultimate lap but slipped off unharmed at turn 4, leaving the win to Burley over Nick Kampenhout and Michael Patchett.

Nick Burke put on a dominant display on his Carl Cox Motorsport Hyosung X4r in the Shoei Junior category by taking three wins on the day.

Hayden Lockhart (Yamaha R3) and Timothy Gray (Yamaha R3) followed across the line in race one, Phillip Lowe (Kawasaki EX250) and Lockhart completed the race two podium while the race three placings were filled by Lockhart and Gray during very wet conditions.

Matt Eggleton took his KiwiSpannz Yamaha FZR1000 to victory in the first NV Motorcycles Senior Post Classic race over similarly mounted SJ Cavell and Mark Hatton.

Kerry Chapman showed the crowd how to ride a small bike in very trying conditions in the under 600cc Junior division, run concurrently, after winning a good battle with Dave Lewis (Honda Hamilton CBR600) and Nigel Lennox (High Rope Access ZXR400), all three were covered by half a second.

Race two was staged in very wet conditions which brought out a superb display of wet weather riding by SJ Cavell, who took line honours from the fighting pair of Juniors

Chapman and Lewis. Hatton was caught out with the wrong tyre choice, but bravely splashed around on slicks to pick up valuable series points, while Matt Eggleton regretted his tyre choice which left him in the gravel trap and out of the race on the warm up lap.

The final Post Classic race was also on a very wet surface, enabling SJ Cavell to continue his masterclass in wet racing, taking the overall again from Eggleton, Chapman and Lewis.

Casey Bullock (Warden Consulting KYM450) dominated the Boyd Motorcycles Supermoto class with three wins. The first on a very wet surface, from Glenn Eggleton (KiwiSpanzz RMZ450) and Tony Hirini. Race two was held in slightly better conditions which saw Luke Cabrol (Arbcon RZ450F) and Glenn Eggleton follow Casey across the line.

Race three saw another shuffle, with Luke Cabrol and Mark Oliver following Casey home.

Hamilton Motorcycle Club rider Andy Harper (Aprilia RSV1000) hogged the top spot of the CTAS Live Clubman sponsored rostrum with three wins, with David Hamilton (KTM690) and Steve Manning (Honda CBR600) sharing second and third placings.

Supermoto competitor Mike Kyle won the Whites Powersports spot prize of a superb pair of Gaerne racing boots. Appreciation is given to Hamilton Motorcycle Club marshals and officials who had to stay out in trying weather conditions all day.

The final round of the 2017 HMCC Putoline Series will be staged at Taupo on October 15.

A horror morning but a Fantastic end result - Mugello, Italy Sep 25 at 6:59am Talk about stress ! (Jo's rundown..)



"Where's the rum I need a drink to calm down" !!

So 20mins from race start, I check the front pressure and the tyre is not 34 it's 19... what the ??

The 90 degree valve stem was loose prior to this morning so we tightened it, but turns out the rubber o ring was lapped so we ran to the spares guy and bought one, but the wrong size so it didn't fit, so we took one off our spare rim with the wet on it, putting the tyre back on the bike 5 mins before pit open,

On start grid we were still perfecting the front tyre pressures for the race, with help and advice from the Aprilia Nuova m2 team boss..

10 lap race start, brilliant start up in 14th place from a 21st position start.

Lap 2 the championship leader crashed out, red flag.

So back into the pits, least we can check the front tyre pressures again and alter them,

Restart race, pit lane open, I run out to the start grid so Dill can find his spot, off I sprint, down pit lane and back up the start grid,

While I'm waiting for Dill to arrive it starts to Rain!! Red flag again! Back I sprint to the Aprilia pit who are helping us with a generator, and now the stress, we have no wets! We took a gamble and didn't buy any, as funds are tight!, even if we had we just still the front wheel valve stem,

Pit lane opens again, after the spits ease, some riders have changed to wets, some not, we had not .. as we didn't have any,

Back to the start grid I run, for the restart restart... I meet Dillon on the start grid and make sure his red light is on as it's declared a wet race.. and check with him how the cold track feels, he tells me its dry and fine.

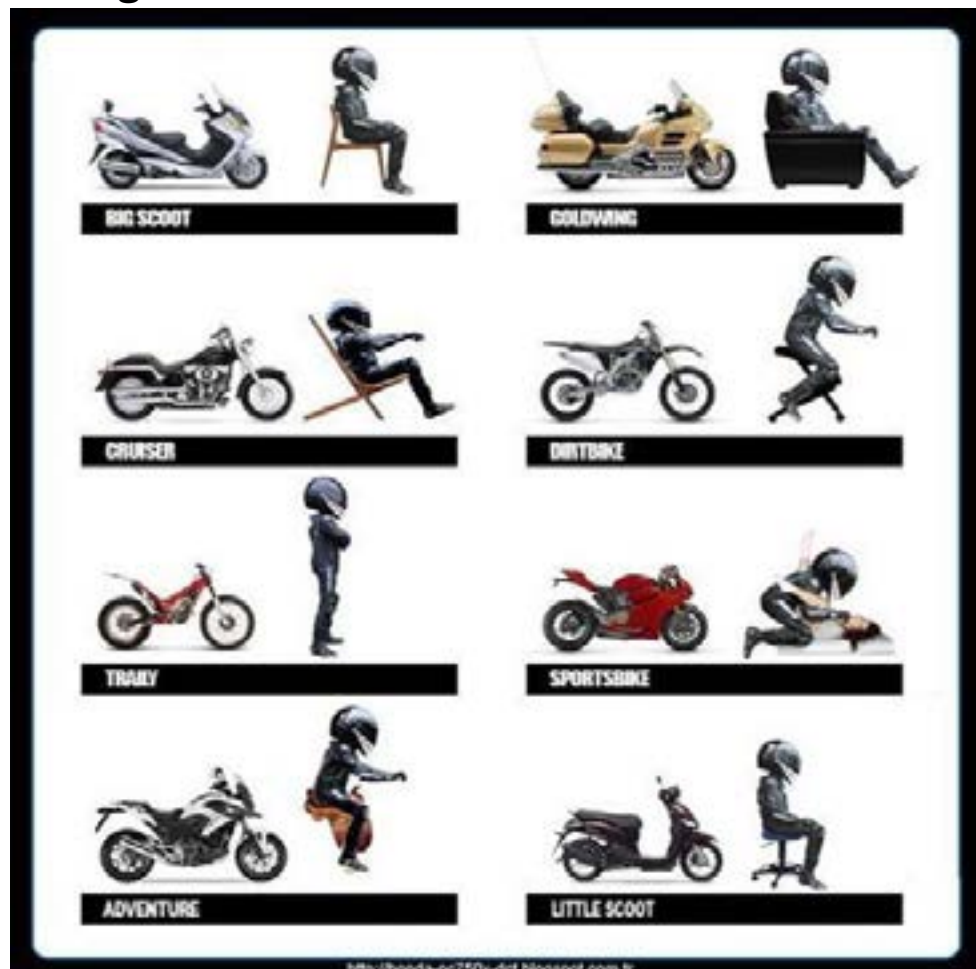
So I wish him luck and run □ off the grid to pit lane,

Off he goes again, great start! Up into 7th and the battle begins, hard to hold onto the back on a ZX10 with 230hp, on a stock Aprilia with only 197hp and on pump fuel down a 1.2km straight, after 8 laps we had slipped back into 10th place, and brought her home there!!

Best place ever!

What a brilliant feeling to crack a big goal of ours!! We can celebrate now!!
