Welcome to McLarenArchive, where you can watch rare New Zealand motor racing films from the 1940s to 1980s, made by the late Alan McLaren.

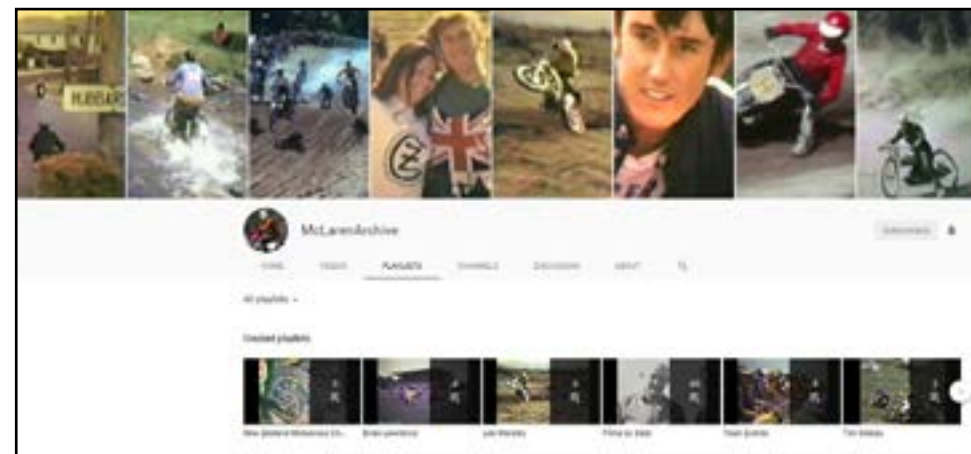
Involved in motorsport - and especially the Hamilton Motor Cycle Club - throughout his life, Alan was also the father of motocross riders Ross and Doug (plus older son Graham), and Uncle of Bruce McLaren.

Alan sent these films (Standard 8mm, where he attached the audio himself, and later Super 8mm) to Ross, in the UK, in the 1980s.

After being converted to digital, they can now be seen for the first time in almost 40 years as a tribute to Alan and all the competitors involved.

Sunday morning at John Arthur's property near Te Pahu was a great place to be as long as you like mud, rain and a challenge.

As this was round 3 of the Championship, it needed to be tough enough to sort out the different levels of skill that on display. It rained. A lot. Not heavy, but persistent enough to need wet weather gear that would keep the rain out and the sweat in.

The sections were more tricky and technical, with only one real hill climb as the banks were quick to gouge up. There are plenty of rocks to climb a fairly full stream to contend with. All made more difficult by the damp conditions.

With three riders from Auckland and three from Tauranga plus five from Hamilton a total of 11 riders made the most of an excellent property to challenge themselves and enjoy the day.

It is still the cheapest form of motor sport in this country and offers a chance to learn a new skill with two wheels, throttle clutch and brake. Anyone wishing to give it a go can contact me and I can arrange a bike at the next event on Aug 12th at Kents Quarry. See the flyer.

2019 NZSBK CHAMPIONSHIP EXPANDS TO FIVE ROUNDS

Hold on to your helmets, road racers! The NZSBK Championship is expanding to five rounds in 2019, with the addition of Manfeild to the second half of the calendar. Great news for motorsport fans too – Circuit Chris Amon at Manfeild is the longest motor racing course with uninterrupted views in the Southern Hemisphere.

The 3km international race circuit, named for kiwi racing legend Chris Amon who oversaw the design of the superfast layout, is known for its banked corners, a unique feature for a NZ motor-racing circuit. 2018 saw some fast and furious racing with tight battles in most classes; the action at Manfeild is sure to offer more of the same.

Misano 1100cc Gabro Tuono Test. Jul 26 at 10:29pm We tested the new 1100cc Tuono on Misano World Circuit on a 4hr open track test on Monday, and back at Misano World Circuit today, getting settled in for race practice tomorrow. Racing this weekend. Patreon sponsors get to see videos of the practise session and discussion of race bike development.

We will likely be the only one in National Trophy with high handle bars, but not the only special /uncommon bike in the field.

Our competition this weekend will not only be 40 seriously fast guys & girls, but a V4 2 stroke! Yes the Suter MMX 500 !!

Here is a Italian to English translation of an article on the National Trophy Facebook page for you all about the Suter's first weekend in Italy.

The starting grid of the National Trophy 1000 is enriched by a new prestigious presence: the Suter MMX500 with a 2-stroke V4 engine from the official Suter team, which will be brought to the race by Fabrizio Lai.

The Swiss bike will debut in the fourth round of the National Trophy at the end of July, at the Misano Adriatico circuit.

Presented to the press in September 2015, the MMX500 made its debut at the Tourist Trophy in 2016 and after a year off it is back to racing at the Isle of Man this year, again with Ian Lougher, English rider who can boast 9 victories at the North West 200, 10 at the TT and 18 at the Ulster Grand Prix.

The bike wanted by Eskil Suter, produced in limited numbers for fans of the two-stroke, is equipped with a 576 cm3 engine, with a power of 195 horses and a weight of only 130 kilos.

Fabrizio Lai, who tested it on June 28 at the Mugello circuit, will bring it to the track in the National Trophy.

"It's an incredible bike - it was his comment after the day of testing with the Turbenthal home bike - which forced me to forget everything I've driven in the last ten years. It has no type of electronic control, it is very rigid and is a real racing bike. Feels every kind of modification and just open the gas to release all of its 195 horses. It requires an extremely physical guide, and after only ten laps the calluses on the hands have opened. You have to guide it with your hands and with your whole body, and moving a lot on the saddle so as not to make it pry off and to insert it in the corners. From some fantastic sensations "

"I can not wait to race at the National Trophy - continues Fabrizio - Sure it will not be easy because the level at the National 1000 is very high, but we are preparing well and for this we did a test at Mugello. We will continue to work on the telemetry and tire selection, in collaboration with Metzeler, whom I thank very much, as I thank the Moto Club Spoleto, for accepting our registration and the Promoracing that allowed us to carry out this test at Mugello ".

Damon Rees Race Report Darwin

Ahead of round 4 of ASBK in Darwin- I was looking forward to some warm weather As it's mid winter here in New Zealand, but in the Top End the weather hardly sees lower then twenty degrees.

The team chose to fly over 5 day's before the event so we had time to acclimatise to the strong heat and humidity of Darwin. We used it as a bit of a holiday, but spent time in the gym, training, so that we were fully prepared for racing.

Day 1 - Thursday was a one hour shake down session to get used to Hidden Valley Raceway again. All went well, my Honda CBR600RR was feeling great and my fitness felt good- so I was rearing to go for racing! After the session we had a new valve spec to try from K-tech in the rear shock to test. Day two was my opportunity to test the changes.

Day two- Friday, consisted of 3x30 minute practice sessions. I was only a few laps into the first session and the bike started to feel unsettled. We found that the rear shock had blown out, causing it to rebound extremely fast. It put an early end to our first thirty minute session, sadly missing out on some important track time. After working on the shock, we were hoping we had fixed the problem, but unfortunately after a few laps into the second session - the same thing had happened again. We decided to put in a standard shock for a the third session, and it immediately felt better, but the settings were very limited because the shock was standard.

After day two, we finished up seventh fastest. It wasn't a bad result considering the day we had, and the lack of riding I got to do. We stripped down the shock one last time and found the problem was the new valve stack we had just fitted on Thursday night. With the help of Shaun Clark from Team Penrite Honda Racing - we fitted a new valve stack to the shock and hoped it worked.

Day three, Saturday consisted of two thirty minute qualifying sessions. The first qualifying went well, as we had no problems with the shock, but we still had a lot to change with the bike as now the rear was working good, but the forks felt a little dead. Unfortunately there was not enough time between qualifying one and two to pull the forks out, so we had to settle with what we had. Luckily, qualifying two was solid and I managed a 6th overall, putting me on the second row of the grid for racing. After qualifying was over, we pulled the forks out and rev alved them. Luckily we had a short morning warm up the next day to see how they felt for the races.

Day four, Sunday, was race day and warm-up was a success, the bike finally felt great! In race one - I got off to a flying start getting into third through turn one and having a tussle with Max Croker, Tom Toparis and Lachlan Epis, while Cru Haliday was on a mission at the front. My Honda CBR600rr was holding it's own well, but after a few laps I fell back to fourth. Which was where I would eventually finish, after some good battles with Lachlan. I was happy with the race as it was the best feeling I'd had with the bike all season! It also boosted my confidence, knowing that I could run up the front.

I got off to another great start in race two, but a few little mistakes in the opening laps caused me to lose the tow from the front three. I once again found myself in fourth, having a good battle with Lachlan Epis. I stayed strong and consistent until the end, and it resulted in another 4th. After two solid races, I have retained third in

the championship - I'm happy with the weekend, I felt fit and fast, and after a lot of hard work, the bike is feeling better than ever! We now look on to Morgan Park in a months time. I'm looking forward to going back to the track that unfortunately ended my ASBK season last year- it's not gonna get me this time!

MNZ Hall of Fame for Tony Rees

Legend of kiwi motorcycling Tony Rees was inducted into the Motorcycling New Zealand Hall of Fame at this year's New Zealand Motorcycle Awards Dinner in May.

Veteran road racer Tony Rees, twice NZSBK Champion, 10 times winner of Paeroa's Battle of the Streets and seven times winner of the Cemetery Circuit feature race, will join the best and fastest of New Zealand's cadre of road racing champions in the Hall of Fame. Hailing from Whakatane, Rees has been racing since 1981, and has passed on his love for speed to his sons, Mitch and Damo. The trio are team mates in the Honda Rider Insurance Team Rees Racing team.

"To ride in a race with my sons is just a pretty amazing feeling actually. And my wife, she's always right there making it happen as well, so it is a real family affair."

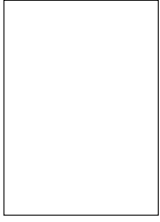
