Prezzo Report

Hi everyone, halfway through the year already and not the best weather for riding but that did not dampen the spirits of those who joined together for the midwinter dip ride to Whangamata. I notice no one was hardy enough to strip off for a swim but as I did not even ride I shall remain quiet.

Registration Changes are coming

To add to the current rule that all new bikes imported over 125cc require ABS from 1st November this will apply to second-hand imports as well. There will be a limited number of exemptions granted each year for enthusiasts

of classic motorcycles. Also, if you have a project bike from days gone by that you are planning to reregister you will have to prove that is was registered overseas or locally previously.

Do not assume that because it has been on our roads before that VTNZ will have a record of it. Due to a fire back when records were on paper, the records of some bikes are no more so to be sure take your Vin and or chassis number in and check before November.

KTM 890 - Review

Most new models are an improvement on previous years, some bikes are slightly better, and some are a huge leap forward. In my opinion, the KTM 890 Duke is the latter. On picking the bike up from Boyd Motorcycles I needed



to double check which bike I was riding as the one the salesman indicated to looked like a 250 or 400. To sit on it felt the same, a 250-trail bike with a comfy seat. Negotiating traffic on the fastest route out of town the throttle response was smooth and predictable. Once I hit the open road, I changed the ride mode from Street to Sport, something that can be done on the move (albeit slowly obviously). The change to power delivery was dramatic, it now pulled hard and linear from stand still through to a stronger top end that you expect from a well-balanced parallel twin. The brakes are sensational! Stronger than I would usually want except for on the race track, but with ABS on guard you wont get caught out before you get used to how little effort it takes to stop. In summary I am amazed that a bike that feels like a mid-sized trail bike performs like a 916.

This Thursday I will be riding the KTM 890 Adventure to Club night come check it out.

There were 10 sections with riders in all three grades that had to cope with sections receiving a severe soaking overnight. Some adjustments were required but the sun appeared soon after 8:30 am with only a couple of light showers during the event. Trees are great for catching rain and storing it until someone is unlucky enough to bump into them!

Sections 1 to 4 were short and sharp but 7 was a relative marathon through the back of the woods. 8,9 and 10 made use of ditches and banks with a decent log on 10. The area on the right of the track has more potential once some clearing is done so a working bee/fun day will be on the cards once the weather improves. Once again, the access via tarmac and metalled roads meant the weather did not play a big part in getting in and out of the venue.

We have kept the entry fee as slim as possible, and encourage you all to come and have a ride - it's a one-off so come along and ride at a comfortable pace and see what you think.


We are holding a Waikato Cup Race at the start of the 3rd round of races, for the top 20 riders across all classes for a great trophy.
