

# **Kent's Quarry**







#### From the club's Historical Archives:

# **Motorcycle Long Jump Recalled**

From the Times June 3, 1953



The Hamilton Motorcycle Club is to apply to the New Zealand Auto-Cycle Union to have a motor-cycle long jump made by a club member, C.T. Clarkin, recognised as a world record. This was stated today by the president of the club, Mr A. S. Harp.

The jump was made by Clarkin at a motor-cycle gymkhana staged by the club in aid of the St John Ambulance Association at Muir Park, Frankton, at the weekend. There was a very large attendance at the gymkhana.

There is some doubt in motor-cycling circles in New Zealand as to who holds the world record for a long jump but it is generally recognised that the figure, prior to Clarkin's attempt, stood at 54 feet.

Clarkin took off from a plank eight feet long and with a rise of 14 inches. The font wheel of his machine, a 350cc Ariel, touched the ground first 59ft 4in from the spot where the machine became airborne. The rear wheel touched down at 59ft 1in.

The motorcycle travelled in a straight line and was in perfect control all the way. About 50 spectators responded to an invitation to check the measurements and expressed themselves as satisfied.

An amateur photographer, who did not, apparently, expect the record to be broken stationed himself where he considered the machine would land. Clarkin sailed past well above his head and he found himself the possessor of a "worm's eye" view of an airborne motor-cycle.


