

## Trial at Quine Road Property.

One week after the Quine road Hill climb, the “feet up” brigade were back at the top end of this road for a crack at Peter Hall’s neat gully, rocks(wet) and hilly property.

A new and exciting venue for trials provided 11 sections for the 27 senior and 2 junior riders.

With a short walk from the pits to the sections it provided plenty of access for spectators (with Gumboots) to something different for riders too. Low wooden tables formed part of some sections that were tight and twisty in most cases. Some gnarly gullies provided a good challenge for two wheels with stream water for lubrication.

The low scores reflected the forecast of heavy rain that did not eventuate, but that did not detract from the smiles all round. Only 1 Mini entered the event but it was good to see three of the little electric bikes present for a ride round the pits, plus one without power or pedals making its way around. There is hope for the future of trials if we spend the time and effort to get the youngsters interested. More on that subject later.

There will be classes for Mini’s (Petrol and electric) at the 2021 Boyd Motorcycles New Zealand Motorcycle Trials Championships on Labour weekend.

The Series had run at a loss the last couple of years, and wasn't getting the support from the riders needed to make it viable, so we are shaking things up a bit, see if this turns out any better!

The Road Race season towards the end of the year is very very busy, so we thought we would try being first cab off the rank, rather than trying to squeeze even more out of the riders mid season.

Pukekohe has undergone more safety improvements, and is now homologated for full on bike racing.

The name, format, and poster are all being developed at the moment, the one here is just an early draft, but with only just over 2 months, we need to get the idea out there if we have any chance of success.


